Profile:

Hertfordshire County Council - with an annual budget approaching 1 billion - is the fifth largest local authority in the country. Hertfordshire is just north of London and has a population size of approximately 1.1 million people; it includes areas such as Watford, Stevenage, St.Albans and Hertford.

Technologies Deployed:

Wireless and Cat6 Data Infrastructure, Routers, Switches, Internet Connectivity.

Works:

Wow WiFi designed, specified and installed a wireless and Cat6 data network with a cloud based software reporting tool. The network was used to monitor energy consumption and temperature in the data centre and to report energy consumption in real-time, across the internet, to a cloud based reporting application.

Hertfordshire County Council were one of the first organisations in the country to be able to monitor their energy in real-time and demonstrate both significant savings and low carbon credentials.
